Introduction

A. Satan offered one threshold to Jesus through compromised worship. **Matt. 4:8-10**

B. God offered a threshold to Moses through uncompromised worship. **Ex. 3:12**

C. God commands Pharaoh to let His people go so that they might worship Him!
(**Ex. 4:23; 7:16; 8:1, 20; 9:1, 13; 10:7**)

D. As the tide begins to turn against him, Pharaoh (a type of Satan?) tries to get Moses to agree to “compromised worship.”

E. Compromise can be good or bad, depending on context:

1) Good compromise: “A settlement in which each side gives up some demands or makes concessions.” (Best example, marriage!)

2) Bad compromise: “A weakening of one’s principles...”

F. Satan can live with you worshipping God, if it is a “compromised worship”
