5. Clapping: **Psalm 47:1**
6. Raised Hands: **Exodus 29:24; Psalm 28:2; 63:1-4; 134:2; 141:2; 1 Tim. 2:8**
7. Shouting: **Joshua 6:16, 20; Judges 7:17-21; Psalm 33:3; 47:1; Zech. 4:1-10;**  
**1 Thess. 4:16**
8. Dancing: **Exodus 15:20; 2 Sam. 6:14; Psalm 30:11-12; 149:3; 150:4; Eccl. 3:4**
